THE PROBLEM

A right-wing backlash is gaining steam across the country and right here in Los Angeles.

TO BEAT THE BACKLASH

LA Forward Action is training and organizing middle-class communities to get involved in local politics and to act in solidarity with coalitions rooted in working-class communities of color.

Over the last year in LA, we've seen a grassroots progressive movement that rejected politics as usual and produced big victories for visionary candidates and causes.

But we are also seeing a powerful, well-funded backlash against officials fighting for real solutions. This backlash threatens to reverse all the progress we made in 2020 and the years leading up to it.

Our organizing allies are anchored in working class Black and brown neighborhoods like South LA and Boyle Heights, and they have long been the heart of LA's movement for racial and economic justice. To achieve our shared goals, we must hold our core voters and also win over undecideds in "swing districts" across the Westside, Valley and Central LA — places where LA Forward Action's member base is particularly strong.

HOW WE ARE DOING IT

People Power to Win Elections

Our neighborhood-based volunteer teams are active year-round, and in the lead-up to the 2022 elections we will recruit 600 volunteers to do 12,000 hours of phone calls, texts, and canvassing that can reach 240,000 voters in swing districts.

We will flex this muscle electorally to:

- Grow the progressive caucus on LA City Council to a majority by 2024.
- Retain a progressive majority on the LA County Board of Supervisors.

Pass the Progressive Agenda

We demand accountability from the leaders we help to elect.

To advance progressive policies and increase transparency at City Hall, we will:

- Build LA's first publicly available legislative tracker to highlight the progress of key local policies as they advance.
- Spur Angelenos to make their voices heard at key moments by driving thousands of messages to local elected offices.

WHAT WE NEED TO SUCCEED

We are raising \$250,000 over the next 12 months to supercharge our digital organizing and voter outreach by hiring our second and third full-time staff members. A Deputy Director to grow and mobilize our grassroots and digital base.

An Organizing & Campaigns Director to build our capacity to pass progressive policies and win elections.

OUR RECORD OF FIGHTING FOR A FAIR, FLOURISHING LA

Helped form and lead the Healthy LA Coalition of over 375 local groups responding to the pandemic, which won 30 crucial policies to protect vulnerable Angelenos.

Drove 3,500 messages to LA City Council and the LA County Board of Supervisors to keep people housed and push for worker protections during the pandemic.

Drove 700 messages to the Governor and the LA City Council that helped decriminalize street vending for the first time in a century.

Drove 450 messages to the LA City Council to pass historic campaign finance reforms in 2018.

Made more than 40,000 calls to voters to help pass Measure J in 2020.

Co-led coalition that achieved the first-ever progressive sweep of neighborhood council elections in 2021, electing 240 progressive candidates with a win-rate of nearly 75%.

Founding steering committee member of the LA chapter of the Working Families Party.

Serve on the steering committee of key housing justice coalitions including ACT-LA and Our Future LA, whose policy wins have created tens of thousands of units of affordable housing.
